SUBJECT: AOP 10.06 – Family Education Rights and Privacy A

(Buckley Amendment)

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Academic Operating Policy and Procedure (AOP) is to promote an understanding and standardization of the Family Education R wits and Privacy Act known at the Buckley Amendment.

REVIEW:

This AOP will be reviewed every four years (or well-ever circumstances require an earlier review) by the <u>Associate Provost for Acade and Affairs (APAA)</u> with recommendations for revision presented to the <u>Provost and Executive Vice President</u>.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (Buckley Amendment) passed by Congress on November 19, 1974, requires a lucational agencies or institutions to provide eligible students access to their educational records.

It also requires that certail identifiable information may not be revealed from a student's educational records to prauthorized third parties without the prior written consent of the student. However, directory information, as defined in the Bulletin, may be released without the written consent of the student.
