SUBJECT: AOP 12.15 - Academic Probation for Undergraduate Students

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Academic Operating Policy and Procedure (AOP) is to assist students who drop below the minimum academic performance required for graduation to reestablish an acceptable academic record.

REVIEW

This AOP will be reviewed by the <u>Associate Provost for Academic Affairs (APAA)</u> with recommendations for revision presented to the <u>Provost and Executive Vice President</u>.

POLICY/PROCEDURE

A student whose cumulative MSU GPA is less than 2.00 at the end of any term will enter the next term on academic probation and will remain on probation until his or her cumulative MSU GPA reaches 2.00 or higher.

After having been notified of probationary status, a student must schedule an appointment with his/her academic advisor or with the departmental probationary advisor (if the department has a probationary advisor) to devise a plan to improve his/her academic performance.
