

OP 01.11: ACCESS TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES

PURPOSE

Mississippi State University (MSU) provides Information Technology (IT) resources to its constituents a broadly as possible in keeping with the mission of the institution. The purpose of this policy is to test those groups which may be provided access to these resources.

POLICY

Access to IT resources at MSU is limited to individuals and organizations whose use is consistent with the mission and purpose of the university in learning, service, and research. The following guidelines and procedures shall apply:

GUIDELINES

- 1. Direct Connections to the MSU Campus Network may be provide for:
 - a. MSU Departments
 - b. Organizations closely affiliated or having a busine's relationship with MSU and housed in university-owned facilities or on university property
 - c. Federal or state government agencies on or ediscont to university property and affiliated with MSU
 - d. Research and Education networks stan at Internet2, MissiON and eduroam
 - e. Commercial Internet Service Providers but only as peering connections for the benefit of MSU
- 2. Accounts on MSU Servers may be provided for:
 - a. MSU students, faculty, staff and retirees
 - b. Individuals affiliated vin MSS through the University's learning, service and research mission
 - c. Individuals having a business relationship with MSU and with a recognized need to interact with MSU on university systems
- 3. Guest access to the MSU retwork may be provided to visitors, but only for defined and strictly limited period of time.

PROCEDURE

Any individual of organization having access to the Internet through MSU, to the MSU campus network, or to MSU saturers is bound to abide by all MSU policies and applicable state and federal legislation governing use of the Internet and MSU IT resources.

Any violation of applicable laws or policies may result in termination of service.

REVIEW

This OP will be reviewed every four years, or sooner if needed, by the Chief Information Officer.
